



Driver in critical condition after single-vehicle crash

ASHEBORO — One person was critically injured after being ejected from a vehicle in a single-vehicle crash Wednesday afternoon.

The N.C. State Highway Patrol, Randolph County EMS and Westside Fire Department responded to the accident on Old County Farm Road at approximately 2:40 p.m.

According to Emergency Services Chief Donovan Davis, the driver was ejected from the vehicle.

A bystander was reportedly performing CPR on the victim when EMS arrived on scene. The victim had a pulse when EMS left the scene to transport the victim to Moses Cone Memorial Hospital.

Davis stated the victim was in critical condition.

A passenger in the vehicle was not injured in the crash, but was also transported to Moses Cone Memorial Hospital to be evaluated.
